

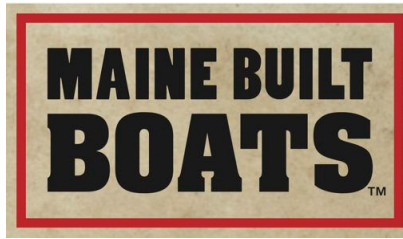


In 1607, the first ship built in America was built in Maine.

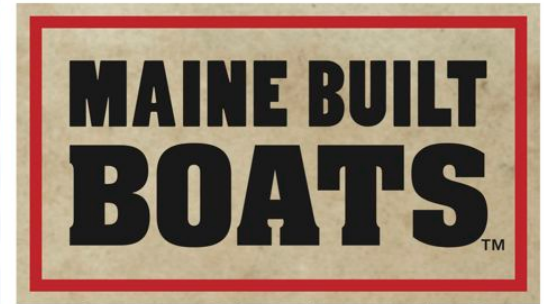
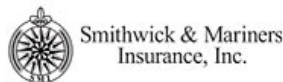
